**Re: Notice of rejection of “representation” – Traffic Management Act 2004**

Your representations against the above Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) have been carefully considered in light of the circumstances at the time and in accordance with the Traffic Management Act 2004, grounds for cancellation of the charge have not been established, this letter is the formal Notice of ‘Rejection of Representations’.

The reasons for rejection are:

In this instance, the PCN was correctly issued. The vehicle was parked in a “Disabled Drivers” bay. The bay was clearly marked and you did not display the relevant badge.

The charge is currently outstanding at £«NOTICES\_FULLCHARGEBALOS»

You can now pay the outstanding balance or appeal against the Council’s decision to the Traffic Penalty Tribunal. Please read information below on how to appeal the Notice further.

If you disagree with the council’s decision you can appeal to the independent adjudicator at the **Traffic Penalty Tribunal**. The adjudicators are independent of the council and their decision is final.

The website explains what the adjudicator can consider and how to appeal. There is no charge for appealing and costs are not normally awarded. The website gives full details. **You will need the information in the box below to hand when you begin your appeal.**

**You should appeal within 28 days of delivery of this Notice of Rejection (usually 2 working days after the ‘Notice of Rejection’ date above – our website explains this)**

If you are unable to appeal online you may request a paper form from the Traffic Penalty Tribunal by calling **01625 44 55 99** and leaving your name, address, telephone number, vehicle registration mark and penalty charge notice number.



Failure to pay, or lodge an appeal, will result in a Charge Certificate being issued which will increase the original charge by 50% to £«NOTICES\_CCBALOS». If this is not paid, legal proceedings will be commenced to recover the money.

**Payment can be made using the following options:**

Online, Telephone, Cash, and by Post using a Credit/Debit Card, Cheque or Postal Order.

In person: at the Customer First Self Pay Kiosk, Municipal Buildings, Corporation St, Blackpool. Please remember to have your PCN number

Automated Payment Line; 01253 478751 (24 hours / 7 days a week). Have card details and Penalty Charge Notice number ready. For security you will be asked to enter the numbers within the post code registered to your payment card. If you receive an error message, this means the numbers have been entered incorrectly or the postcode is incorrect, your payment will need to be made again.
