The penalty charge will be reduced by a **discount of 50%** to \pounds «PCN_Amount_of_First_Discount» if it is paid not later than the last day of the period of 14 days beginning with the date on which this PCN was served i.e. «PCN_Issue_Date_13».

- If you believe that the Penalty Charge Notice should not be paid, make a challenge. The appeals link will provide more information about challenging and will allow you to view the details and photographs of the PCN which are available 24 hours from the PCN issue date. All challenges received before the Notice to Owner is served will be considered. All cases will be considered on their individual circumstances. If you challenge this PCN within 14 days and the challenge is rejected the Council will decide in each case whether or not to extend the period within which the reduced Penalty Charge may be paid.

If the Penalty Charge is not paid or challenged

If the penalty charge is not paid on or before the end of the 28 day period as specified on the front of this notice or successfully challenged the Council may serve a Notice to Owner (NTO) on the owner of the vehicle requiring payment of the Penalty Charge. The owner can then make representations to the Council and may appeal to an independent adjudicator if those representations are rejected. The NTO will contain instructions for doing this. If you challenge this PCN but the Council issues a NTO anyway, the owner must follow the instructions on the NTO.
