CONDITIONS OF ISSUE OF A PARKING PERMIT

- 1. The vehicle should be parked wholly within a marked bay and in accordance with the current Parking Places Order, a copy of which may be inspected at Parking Services at the address shown overleaf. Failure to comply with the terms of the Parking Places Order will result in a Penalty Charge.
- The Purchase of a permit does not guarantee the availability of a space.
- 3. The permit must be firmly attached and displayed in a prominent position on the inside of the windscreen.
- 4. The permit is not transferable and is only valid for the vehicle(s) specified on the permit.
- 5a. The Contract Permit is **only** valid in those car parks in the Contract Parking Permit Scheme.
- 5b. The Resident/Visitor's Only Permit is only valid in the appropriate Residents Only Zone.
- 6. The vehicle may be parked in any marked bay in the car parks in the permit scheme except a bay designated for the use of disabled badge holders.
- 7. The permit is only valid for the period of the week specified on the permit. A valid parking ticket is required at all other times of operation of the Pay and Display scheme.
- Application for the replacement of lost, stolen or mislaid parking permits will only be considered if
 made in writing explaining the circumstances and such replacement shall incur a fee of £30 to cover
 the administration costs.
- 9. No refund will be given for the surrender of a Resident/Visitor Permit prior to its expiry date.
- 10. The issue of a permit does not guarantee that the permit will be extended for a further period beyond the expiry date.
- 11. The Council accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to vehicles or their contents unless such loss or damage is caused by the negligence of Bury Council, its servants or agents.
- 12. The Council reserve the right to close all or part of a car park at any time after giving due notice and during the period of any such closure or part closure the permit for the car park so affected, will be valid on all other car parks included in the permit scheme (the availability of a space cannot be guaranteed).
- 13. The permit holder must notify Parking Services of a change of address. Failure to do so could prejudice the opportunity to renew a permit.
