

PENALTY CHARGE NOTICE (PCN)

Traffic Management Act 2004,s.78: Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007; Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) Representations and Appeals Regulations 2007.

Where the Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) w2as served with a prefix of YA, the Enforcement Authority is Cambridgeshire County Council. In the case where the prefix is YB, the Enforcement Authority is Cambridge City Council , with Cambridgeshire County Council acting as its agent.

BY TELEPHONE: Using Debit or Credit card, payments can be made anytime on 0845 452 2350 using touchtone facilities The parking enforcement services team can also be contacted on 01223 727900 during the hours of 9am to 5pm Monday to Thursday, Friday 9am to 4.30pm (excluding Public holidays).

BY POST: Cheques or postal orders must be made payable in £ Sterling to Cambridgeshire County Council and should be posted, along with the completed payment slip to:- Parking Enforcement Services, PO Box 121, Cambridge, CB1 2WW. Please include the PCN number, your address/contact details on the reverse and DO NOT SEND CASH

If you believe that the penalty should not be paid and wish to make representations against this PCN

Data Protection Act (1998). We will respond/leave a message using the telephone number/email address you provide, unless you state otherwise. The Parking Enforcement Services Team will consider all representations received before a Notice to Owner (see below) is served; details of the Enforcement Authority's policy and approach to representations can be found at www.cambridgeshire.gov.uk/parkingticket. If you make representations against this PCN by not later than the last day of a 14 day period commencing with the date on which this PCN was served (see front of PCN for date) and your representations are rejected, the Parking Enforcement Services Team will generally extend the period within which the reduced payment may be paid.

If the Penalty Charge is not paid or if representations are made unsuccessfully

If no successful representation is made against the penalty charge or if it is not paid on or before the end of the 28 day period as specified on the front of this notice, the Enforcement Authority may serve a Notice to Owner (NtO) on the person who appears to them to be the owner of the vehicle requiring payment of the penalty charge. The owner can then make representations to the Enforcement Authority and may appeal to an independent adjudicator if those representations are rejected. If a NtO is served notwithstanding those initial representations against the PCN, further representations against the PCN must be made in the form and manner and at the time specified in the NtO.
