City of Coventry (Tile Hill Lane) (Bus Lane & Revocation) Order 2011

Highways - neaged

The Council of the City of Coventry ("the Council"), in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and 124(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 21st day of February 2011, and may be cited as the "City of Coventry (Tile Hill Lane) (Bus Lane & Revocation) Order 2011".
- 2. (i) In this Order:-
 - (a) a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the Article of this order so numbered;
 - (b) "authorised vehicle" means a licensed private hire vehicle
 - (c) "bus" has the same meaning as in regulation 22 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;
 - (d) "carriageway" has the same meaning as in section 329(1) of the Highways Act 1980;
 - (e) "cause" includes permit and causing shall be construed accordingly;
 - (f) "enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment;
 - (g) "goods" means goods or burden of any description and includes postal packets of any description and "delivering and "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection.
 - (h) "hackney carriage" means a vehicle licensed under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, Section 6 of the Metropolitan Carriages Act 1869 and any other relevant enactment;
 - (i) "pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002:
 - (j) "private hire vehicle" means a vehicle licensed under Section 48 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 or any similar enactment
 - (k) "vehicle" includes any part of a vehicle
 - (ii) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined in the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by the Council cause or permit any vehicle to be in and/or proceed in the length of road described in the First Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle listed in the Second Schedule to this Order
- 5 The Order detailed in the Third Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
- 6. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order shall be read and construed as not being in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.

FIRST SCHEDULE

The nearside lane of Tile Hill Lane (inbound Carriageway) is hereby designated a bus lane from a point 35 metres west of its junction with the A45 Fletchamstead Highway to its junction with Renolds Close.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to a:-

- (a) bus
- (b) pedal cycle
- (c) vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance service purposes in circumstances of an emergency
- (d) vehicle being used for:-
 - (i) the removal of any obstruction to traffic
 - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road
 - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair or any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus
 - (iv) the repair, replacement, maintenance or cleaning of any bus stop or shelter
- (e) local authority, water or sewage undertaker in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
- (f) hackney carriage
- (g) authorised vehicle
- (h) any vehicle being used in accordance with and indication given by a traffic sign which has been placed pursuant to Sections 66 and 67 of the Act.
