

VISITOR PERMIT T+C'S.

INSTRUCTIONS

- With a coin scratch out one panel from each of the following sections for the day you wish to use this permit:
 - a) Month
 - b) Day
 - c) Date
- Write clearly in ink the vehicle registration number and the address of the house you are visiting, including any flat number.
- Display the completed permit by placing the permit in clear view on the dashboard with the scratched off panels facing upwards.

CONDITIONS OF USE

- This permit is only valid for use by visitors to addresses in the zone specified on the front of the permit. Failure to display a valid permit and park in accordance with regulations may result in a P.C.N. being issued to your vehicle.
- 2) This permit must be clearly displayed in accordance with the above instructions.
- This permit is invalid if more than one month, day or date are scratched out. It is also invalid if no month, or day or date are scratched out.
- This permit is valid in all Residents Bays in the zone specified on the front of the permit.
- 5) This permit is valid on the date you have indicated on the front and until 10.00 am the following day. You will need another Visitors' Permit if you will be staying until after 10.00 am the following day if residents' parking is operational.
- 6) This permit does not guarantee the holder a space or unrestricted right to a space, nor does it render the Council subject to any liability in respect of theft of or damage to any vehicle in a parking place, or the contents or fittings of any such vehicle.

DISPENSATION T+C'S.

INSTRUCTIONS

On arrival:

- Scratch out one panel from each of the sections overleaf to show date of use and start of time period. All six sections must be scratched off for the permit to be valid.
- Write a contact name and telephone number, and work type and location, e.g. Plumbing at No. 10, in pen in the spaces provided.
- The permit must then be displayed face up in a prominent position on the dashboard of the vehicle so that it is clearly visible from the pavement to a Civil Enforcement Officer.

Failure to comply fully with these instructions invalidates the permit, and you may receive a parking fine.

CONDITIONS OF USE:

You must be working from, or need frequent access to, the vehicle in which the permit is displayed throughout the period you are parked.

Once validated this permit permits parking for up to 3 hours in Residents Only Parking Spaces, Resident Only Parking Zones, Limited Waiting Bays or On Street Pay & Display Bays, or shared use bays marked as exempt for residents. This permit does not guarantee the user a space to park.

This Permit is NOT valid for use on any yellow line restrictions, with or without yellow kerb marks, loading bays, disabled parking bays, taxi, bus or Police marked spaces.

You must NOT park in such a manner as to cause an obstruction or hazard to pedestrians or other road users.

You must be prepared to move the vehicle at any time if asked to do so, by a Civil Enforcement Officer or Police officer.

This permit wil! not be valid unless it has been completed in accordance with these instructions. Permits remain the property of the Council and may be withdrawn at any time by notice given to the permit holder.

This permit is valid for one use only and not transferable.
