## 7 DAY SCRATCH CARD PARKING PERMIT

ON ARRIVAL SCRATCH OUT **ONE DAY, DATE AND MONTH** AND WRITE IN YEAR. THE PERMIT MUST BE PLACED IN A PROMINENT POSITION ON THE DASH BOARD INSIDE THE VEHICLE FACE UP SO THE PERMIT DETAILS ARE CLEARLY VISIBLE. FOR FULL INSTRUCTIONS AND CONDITIONS SEE OVER.

## **PARKING PERMIT**

**THIS PERMIT IS ONLY VALID IN BAYS WHERE SIGNS STATE  
'RESIDENT PERMIT HOLDERS' IT IS NOT VALID IN ANY  
OTHER LOCATION INCLUDING PAY & DISPLAY AREAS.**

### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1) With a coin scratch out one panel from each of the following sections on the day of arrival.
  - (i) Day
  - (ii) Date (only scratch off the start date)
  - (iii) Month
  - (iv) Write in the yearThe permit is only valid for seven consecutive days including the start date.
- 2) This permit is transferable, between vehicles within the seven consecutive days. Only ONE vehicle is entitled to use the permit at any given time.
- 3) Write details of where you are visiting in the relevant box. eg the name of the hotel/guest house and street name of the property you are staying at.
- 4) The permit must be placed in a prominent position on the dashboard nearest the kerb inside the vehicle face up so the permit details are clearly visible.
- 5) The permit must be continuously displayed between the hours stated in the Controlled Parking Zones order, as indicated on the relevant signs.

### **CONDITIONS OF USE**

- Permits are valid up to 10am on the day after the expiry day
- Permits are only valid when used by persons visiting or staying at the property issuing the permit.
- Permits must not be used by owners or staff of hotel/guesthouse accommodation.
- The issue of a permit does not guarantee to the holder a space to park nor does it render the Council subject to any liability in respect of loss or damage to any vehicle in a parking place or the contents or fittings of any such vehicle.
- The use of parking places may be suspended by Police Officers, Civil Enforcement Officers or duly authorised Council Officers.
