The relevant extract in our cancellation guidance document is as follows:

I enclose photographs of your vehicle parked in contravention of the Regulations which also shows the PCN affixed to your vehicle. It is possible that a third party may have removed the Notice before you returned. I am therefore prepared to accept the discounted amount of £35 if it is received within 14 days of the date of service of this Notice of Rejection.

There are two options available to you:

You must now decide whether to pay the penalty charge or whether to appeal.

NOTE: If you do not appeal and do not pay the penalty charge within the period set above, the full charge of 70 will be due, and East Sussex County Council may serve a charge certificate on you that will increase the penalty by a further 50%. See below for how to pay or how to appeal.

- By phone, call our automated payment line 0345 658 5500 (24 hours, 7 days a week). Please have your card, vehicle registration and PCN number ready.
- By post, send a cheque or postal order made payable to 'East Sussex County Council'. This should be sent to PO Box 80, Lewes, BN7 2WU. Please include the PCN number with your payment. Allow 2 working days for 1<sup>st</sup> class post and 5 working days for 2<sup>nd</sup> class.
- In person, at

  - The Parking Shop, Causeway House, Wellers Yard, 46-48 Malling Street, Lewes, BN7 2RH

## How to appeal

If you disagree with the council's decision you can appeal to the independent adjudicator at the **Traffic Penalty Tribunal**. The adjudicators are independent of the council and their decision is final.

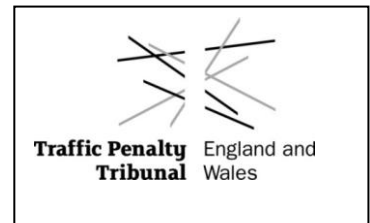
