## **CONDITIONS OF USE**

- Visitor Permits are available for your visitors to park in Shepway District Council Controlled Parking Zone A2.
- The Visitor Permit entitles your visitor to park in Permit Holder Parking Places, or Chargeable and Permit Holder Parking Places.
- The vehicle must be parked within the bay markings.
- Scratching off the relevant day, date, month, year and entering the vehicle registration number in ink will validate the Visitor Permit.
- 5. A new Permit must be used each day.
- 6. Any attempt to alter the Permit will render it invalid.
- The Visitor Permit must be displayed in a prominent position on the dashboard of the vehicle so that the whole face can be clearly seen from the outside of the vehicle.
- 8. Issuing a Visitor Permit does not guarantee the availability of a parking space.
- 9. The Visitor Permit does not allow the holder to park on single or double yellow lines.
- Parking bays may be suspended from time to time and users should check that a bay is in operation before parking.
- 11. The Permit is only valid in vehicles no longer than 5.6 metres and no heavier than 5 tonnes fully laden.
- 12. Failure to comply with the above conditions may result in a Penalty Charge Notice being served.
- 13. These Permits are not refundable.
