All-Island Car Park Permit - Terms and Conditions

1. The cost of an All-Island Car Park Permit will be £295 and the cost with the Supplementary Parking Permit will be £420. Supplementary Parking Permits will always expire on the same date as your all-Island Car Park Permit. Payments can be made in full by debit/credit card or by direct debit*.
*Instalments will be collected over 10 months at £29.50 per month or £42.00 per month respectively. The first payment will be due at the time of application and must be made by credit/debit card. Direct

debits will be collected from the 20th of each subsequent month.

Failure to maintain your direct debit payments will result in the full balance becoming immediately due and the vehicle may be liable to receive penalty charge notices until such a time as the permit is returned or full payment received.

- 2. Permits will be issued from the 1st of the month in which they are applied (unless otherwise requested) and are valid for a 12 month period.
- 3. The supplementary permit can only be purchased at the same time of applying for the All-Island Car Park Permit and will always expire on the same date as your All-Island Car Park Permit.
- 4. The All-Island Car Park Permit is only valid within Council owned car parks in accordance with the terms and conditions of the permit and the current parking places order. The permit is not valid in any other parking location.
- 5. The issue of a permit does not guarantee the availability of a parking space. It merely entitles the specified vehicle to park in any of the designated off-street parking areas if there is sufficient space. Your permit cannot be used to park in any other area than those stated.
- 6. A duplicate permit may be issued if you change your vehicle. The old permit must be surrendered as a replacement **will not** be issued without the return of the existing permit. An administration charge of £10.00 + VAT will be made for the issue of such a permit. You must contact parking services immediately by email to parking.services@iow.gov.uk or telephone 01983 823714.
- 7. The permit must be clearly displayed inside the front nearside of the windscreen and remains the property of the Isle of Wight Council. Failure to clearly display the permit for whatever reason will render the driver liable to a penalty charge notice.
- 8. Your permit cannot be used in any vehicle other than the vehicle specified on the permit. Should you have a Courtesy Vehicle from a garage you must contact parking services immediately by email to parking.services@iow.gov.uk or telephone 01983 823714.
- 9. Permits must be surrendered to the Council if:
- You no longer own the vehicle that the permit was issued for.
- The vehicle is adapted or used in such a way that it no longer qualifies for a permit.
- You require the issue of a duplicate or replacement permit.
- 10. A refund will be made on the remaining full months, less a £10.00 + VAT administration charge. The old permit must be surrendered as a refund will not be issued without this being received. Please note that if you cancel your direct debit, and your permit is not received by Parking Services, you will remain liable for the full cost of the parking permit until such time as it is received into our office.
