Tickets and permits

Must be displayed at all times in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the ticket or permit is clearly legible from outside the vehicle.

Tickets are not transferable between car parks, on-street parking areas, persons or vehicles.

Trailers Must be attached to the towing vehicle at all times. A ticket must be purchased for both the towing vehicle and the trailer. Both tickets must be displayed clearly in the towing vehicle.

No person shall use a vehicle whilst in a parking place as sleeping accommodation, or for camping, cooking, or sanitary purposes, whether by day or by night and shall not use the parking place for any purpose other than parking the vehicle.

Penalty Charge Notice
