Please remember to allow enough time for your payment to arrive at the Council offices before the payment deadline. The Post Office does not guarantee a next day delivery for first class post.

Should you fail to make payment we will be obliged to register the debt at the County Court. If the Court agrees to issue a warrant it will be transferred to an Enforcement Agent for collection. Under the terms of The Taking Control of Goods (Fees) Regulations 2014 this will add an immediate fee of £75.00 to the balance outstanding. This is a fixed fee payable by you. If the Enforcement Agent has to visit your address this will incur an additional fixed fee of £235.00. These fees are fixed by law and cannot be reduced or waived. Fees Recoverable are shown below.
