How to make representations against the Penalty Charge

If you do not think that you should have to pay this Penalty Charge, you may make representations to the Authority either online at www.leicester.gov.uk or in writing by post to Leicester City Council, Bus Lane Enforcement, Central Post Room, Pilot House 41 King Street, Leicester LE1 6RN. Telephone queries should be made on 0116 2335555.

The Bus Lane Contraventions (Penalty Charges, Adjudication and Enforcement) (England) Regulations 2005 (SI No. 2757) sets out six grounds on which you may make representations. These are set out below, together with an indication of the information that should be supplied in support of your representations. Tick the relevant boxes and write your reasons in the box provided. However, the Council may consider other mitigating circumstances and you should tick the box "Other reasons" and give full details. This Penalty Charge will be cancelled if one or more of the specified grounds are established.

If your representations are received in time or are received late but are taken into account, the authority will consider them and let you know its decision in writing. If your representations are rejected you have the right to appeal against that decision to an independent Adjudicator. An appeal form will be sent with the letter rejecting your representations. The form will explain how and when to appeal to the Adjudicator.
