After a review of the information provided in your submitted declaration form, the Secretary of State acknowledges that the device described in your application:

- meets the requirements, and is approved for the purposes of, Regulation 4 and Schedule 1 to the 2022 Regulations for the enforcement types specified above, and
- (Where bus lane is specified in enforcement type above and the applicant is a Traffic Authority within Greater London), is approved for the purposes of bus lane enforcement under Part II and paragraph 7(2) of Schedule 1 to the London Local Authorities Act 1996.

The device is therefore certified for use in relation to the civil enforcement of road traffic contraventions in the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne area.
