You can apply for your permit on-line at <u>parking.northumberland.gov.uk</u>. On-line is the quickest and easiest method and your permit will normally be processed and sent to you within 2 working days. However if you renew your permit more than a week in advance, your permit will not be sent out to you until one week prior to the start date.

Alternatively you can and either;-

- Telephone 0345 600 6400 and a customer service advisor will process your application and take your payment or
- complete a permit application form (available to download from our website or from Information Centres) and either:-
 - take it to one of our Information Centres where you can make payment by debit/credit card, cash or cheque or
 - post your completed form and cheque (made payable to 'Northumberland County Council') to Parking Services, County Hall, Morpeth, Northumberland, NE61 2EF.

All permits are sent by post - we are unable to issue permits direct to personal callers.

<u>Please Note</u>: The Northumberland Pay and Display Parking Permit is valid in the following Pay and Display off-street car parks operated by Northumberland County Council: **Berwick Railway Station**, **Corbridge**, **Craster**, **Holy Island**, **Newton by the Sea** and **Seahouses**. Where there are time restrictions you must display a timer disc with your permit on the inside of your windscreen. You must not stay longer than the maximum stay permitted. **Failure to display a valid permit will result in a Penalty Charge Notice of up to £70 being issued – expired permits will not be accepted**.
