Visitor Permit

- 1. This permit is the property of Nottinghamshire County Council to whom it should be returned when the resident sells or tenant vacates the property. Permit holders may apply for a duplicate if the permit is lost, stolen, destroyed, mutilated or accidentally defaced. Any person found responsible for altering a permit is liable for prosecution.
- 2. This permit must be clearly visible from the front nearside of the vehicle. It should be displayed in the protective holder provided when the vehicle is left in an appropriate parking space during
- permitted hours.

 3. This permit has been issued subject to the conditions. If it appears that the vehicle has not been used in accordance with the conditions, the Council reserves the right to revoke the permit.
- 4. A permit is valid if the expiry date shown has not passed, and the
- permit is properly displayed.

 5. Responsibility for applying for renewal of the permit rests with the resident or tenant and they may renew their permits within 21 days in advance of the expiry date.
- 6. The issue of this permit does not guarantee the holder a parking space nor does it render the issuer subject to any liability in respect of loss or damage to any vehicle in a parking space or the contents or fittings of any such vehicle.
