How to make representations

Representations which are made after the end of the 28 day period specified on the first page of this Penalty Charge Notice may be disregarded. This Notice will be taken to have been served on the second working day after the day of posting unless you can show that it was not. If you submit your representations late, you should explain why.

The statutory grounds on which representations may be made are set out on page 3, together with an indication of the information which you should supply in support of your representations. It is important to provide all relevant information. Tick the relevant boxes and write your reasons in the box on the following page. This Notice **will** be cancelled if one or more of the statutory grounds is established. This Notice **may** be cancelled for other compelling reasons even if none of the statutory grounds apply. If the Notice is cancelled any sums already paid will be refunded.

If your representations are received in time or are received late but are taken into account, Portsmouth City Council will let you know its decision in writing. If your representations are rejected, you have the right to appeal against that decision on any of the statutory grounds to the independent Bus Lane Adjudicator. The letter rejecting your representations will explain how and when to appeal to the adjudicator.

You may view the still images/video footage using the Council's website **parkingtickets.portsmouth.gov.uk** You may also make a request to review the recording at the Civic Offices, during office hours. This request must be in writing. You may also make a written request for a still image of the contravention to be sent to you. These services are free of charge.

Data Protection Information

Personal data has been collected in order to serve this Penalty Charge Notice and enforce the parking terms and conditions. Also you may write to us and provide personal data. As a contravention has been observed, your personal data may be collected, processed, shared and retained in order to carry out the performance of a public task and fulfil our legal obligations in the following ways:

- To request details of the registered keeper of the vehicle from the DVLA in order to pursue a Penalty Charge Notice.
- Shared with third parties for appeals and enforcement.
- Shared with the police or security organisations to prevent or detect crime.

Your Data Rights

In relation to the personal data which we may hold about you, you have the right to request to: Be informed, have access or rectify incorrect information. You also have the right to object to or restrict our processing of your data.

Under Data Protection law we must verify your identity and explain to you our reasons if we do not agree to carry out your request.
