

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of the conditions of use of areas of road that may be used only by buses and other specified classes of vehicular traffic, in King's Road, Reading, hereby:

- authorises the erection at the sites indicated schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/124/0013-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/124/0013-2; and
- authorises the erection at the sites indicated schematically on the said plan of a traffic sign consisting of a plate (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised plate") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the said drawing; and
- directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 20(1) of the Traffic Signs
 General Directions 2002 (Part II of S.I. 2002/3113), the authorised sign shall be used in
 combination with the authorised plate; and
- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign and the authorised plate may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and



5. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign and the authorised plate at the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and the authorised plate and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18, 19 and 24 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of S.I. 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations") shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 953 in Schedule 5 to those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 12 and 20 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate in the same manner as they apply to the plate shown in diagram 953.2 in Schedule 5 to those Regulations.




