## **HOW TO APPEAL**

You may appeal against this decision to an independent Adjudicator.

Any appeal must be made before the end of the period of 28 days beginning with the date of service of this Notice but the Adjudicator may decide to allow you a longer period - see below.

A notice of appeal-

- (a) must be in writing signed by you or by someone who you have authorised to sign on your behalf;
- (b) must state your name and address or some other address to which you want documents to be sent to you in connection with the appeal;
- (c) must state the date and any reference number of the disputed decision and the name of the enforcement authority; and
- (d) may include any representations which you want to make in addition to the original representations.

If the notice of appeal is sent after the end of the 28-day period specified above you must provide a statement setting out the reasons for the delay. The Adjudicator will then treat that statement of reasons for delay as a request to extend the time limit. The form for making an appeal is enclosed with this Notice.

The Adjudicator will not normally make an order awarding costs and expenses either to an appellant or to an enforcement authority but may do so where the Adjudicator is of the opinion that one of those parties to the appeal has acted frivolously or vexatiously or that the conduct in making, pursuing or resisting an appeal was wholly unreasonable. No order for costs would be made without giving the affected party an opportunity of making representations against the making of the order.
