This Warning Notice has been served on you because it appears to SANDWELL COUNCIL that you HAVE PARKED YOUR VEHICLE IN CONTRAVENTION. This car park is a pay and Display Car park as of 1st November 2016. The council is using the period between 15th October and 31st October 2016 to warn motorists of the charges that apply from 1st October 2016, however deferred until 1st November 2016.

As of 1st October 2016 a valid Traffic Regulation Order applies on this car park. However, no Penalty Charge Notices will be issued in the month of October whilst the motorists and users of the car park are warned through this notice.

Please note that a valid permit or a pay and display ticket will be required to be displayed as of 1st November 2016. Failure to do so may result in issuing of a Penalty Charge Notice

On the above date your vehicle was observed in Park Farm Car Park without a valid pay and display ticket or a permit. You do not need to take any further action with regards to this warning notice, as NO PAYMENT is required,

This notice has been issued to raise awareness of the recent commencement of the enforcement of new charges in West Bromwich Street Car Park by the Council. To make motorists aware of this recent change we have issued a number of warning notices. However, from Tuesday 1st November 2016 vehicles parked without a pay and display ticket or permit or not complying with the conditions may receive a Penalty Charge Notice of £50/£70, discounted to £25/£35 if paid within 14days of the discount period.
