THE RULE RELATING TO SERVICE

Service by post

- 3 (1) Subject to paragraph (5), any notice (except a penalty charge notice served under regulation 9) or charge certificate under these Regulations
 - a) may be served by first class (but not second class) post; and
 - b) where the person on whom it is to be served is a body corporate, is duly served if it is sent by first class post to the secretary or clerk of that body.

(2) Service of a notice or charge certificate contained in a letter sent by first class post which has been properly addressed, pre-paid and posted shall, unless the contrary is proved, be taken to have been effected on the second working day after the day of posting.

- (3) In paragraph (2), "working day" means any day except
 - a) a Saturday or a Sunday;
 - b) New Year's Day;
 - c) Good Friday;
 - d) Christmas Day;
 - e) any other day which is a bank holiday in England and Wales under the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971.
- (4) A document may be transmitted to a vehicle hire firm (as defined in regulation 5(4)) by a means of electronic data transmission where—
 - a) the vehicle hire firm has indicated in writing to the person sending the notice document that it is willing to regard a document as having been duly sent to it if it is transmitted to a specified electronic address; and
 - b) the document is transmitted to that address.
- (5) Nothing in this regulation applies to the service of any notice or order made by a county court.

For the purposes of this Charge Certificate the "relevant period" means:

- a) Where a Notice of Rejection is served but no appeal is made, the period of 28 days beginning with the date of service of the Notice of Rejection;
- b) Where there has been an unsuccessful appeal against the imposition of the Penalty Charge, the period of 28 days beginning with the date on which the adjudicator's decision is sent to the appellant pursuant to regulation 22(6);
- c) Where an appeal is withdrawn, the period of 14 days beginning with the date on which it is withdrawn; and
- d) Where no representations are made, the period of 28 days beginning with the date on which the Penalty Charge Notice is served.
