This notice has been issued to raise awareness of the recent commencement of the enforcement of bus lane contravention by the Council. To make motorists aware of this recent change we have issued a number of warning notices. However, from (merge date) vehicles captured by CCTV using a bus lane during restricted hours may receive a Penalty Charge Notice of £60, discounted to £30 if paid within 14 days from the date of service of the notice.
