PENALTY CHARGE NOTICE (PCN)

A penalty charge of **£70/£50** is now payable and must be paid not later than the last day of the period of 28 days beginning with the date on which the PCN was served. The penalty charge will be reduced by a discount of 50% to **£35/£25** if it is paid not later than the last day of the period of 14 days beginning with the date on which the PCN was served.

For instructions on how to pay or challenge this PCN please see over.

If the **Penalty Charge is not paid or challenged**. If the penalty charge is not paid on or before the end of the 28 day period as specified or successfully challenged the Enforcement Authority may served a Notice to Owner (NtO) on the owner of the vehicle requiring payment of the penalty charge. The owner can then make representations to the Enforcement Authority and may appeal to an independent adjudicator if those representations are rejected. The NtO will contain instructions for doing this. The enforcement authority will consider representations received before an NtO is issued. If you challenge this PCN but the Enforcement Authority issues an NtO anyway, the owner must follow the instructions on the NtO.
