

Resident Concessionary Season Tickets

General Information

- Concessionary car parking season tickets are available to residents of streets on the town centre area which have pay and display parking bays. These season tickets allow parking in the pay & display bays without the purchase of a “fee paid” ticket.
- They do not guarantee a parking space, nor do they permit parking on yellow lines or in any other area where parking is prohibited (such as loading bays, disabled bays)
- A maximum of 2 concessionary season tickets per household is allowed
- Applicants are required to provide proof of links between themselves, the residence at which they must be a domestic resident, and the vehicle, at the time of application and any subsequent renewal
- The concessionary season ticket is normally valid for 12 months from the date of issue
- Concessionary season tickets are issued for private motor cars (and private light goods) vehicles only.
- A concessionary season ticket will cease to be valid when the vehicle is sold or there is a change of keeper, or the applicant moves from the address for which the season ticket was applied.
- If you change vehicles and therefore need to change your permit, you must supply proof of ownership for the new vehicle and return the old permit along with an administration charge of £5. Replacement permits take a minimum of 5 days to process

Town Centre Ticket Zone

Please note, town centre concessionary season tickets are valid for Pay & Display bays in the street of residence only (not car parks) and no other streets within the zone. Those residing within the following streets may apply:-

London Road, nos. 2 to 86d (evens) inclusive and 1 to 61a (odds) inclusive only

Nelson Street*

Queens Road, from Gordon Road eastwards to the town centre

Southchurch Road nos. 18 to 114 (evens) inclusive and 55 to 143 (odds) inclusive only

Victoria Avenue Service Road*

Warrior Square* (including Warrior Square North and Warrior Square East)

Weston Road*

Whitegate Road*

York Road, nos. 28 to 60 (evens) inclusive and 31 to 49 (odds) inclusive only

Seafront Parking Zone

Residents of the following streets may apply for the concessionary season ticket:-

The High Street, Old Leigh*

Chalkwell Esplanade, nos. 1 to 111 inclusive only

The Leas, between Crowstone Avenue and Grosvenor Road

Eastern Esplanade, nos. 1 to 64 inclusive only

Places of use are as for a standard Seafront season ticket which are :-

Belton Gardens (north and south) car parks

Leigh Foundry CP

Victoria Wharf CP

Shorefield Road CP

Fairheads Green CP

Thorpe Esplanade CP

Shoebury Common (North and South) CP

Shoebury East Beach CP

Belton Bridge bays

Chalkwell Esplanade bays

Eastern Esplanade – Marine Parade to Victoria Road only

Clifftown Parking Zone

Clifftown Zone concessionary season tickets are valid for use only in Pay & Display bays within the zone. They are not valid for use at nearby car parks or Pay & Display bays in adjacent zones.

Residents of those properties that lie within this controlled parking zone are eligible to apply. Only residents of the following properties are eligible:-

Alexandra Road, Nos. 59 to 67 (odds) inclusive only

Cambridge Road, Nos. 1 to 57 (odds) inclusive and 8 to 12a (evens) incl. 30, 34, and 36 only

Capel Terrace *

Cashiobury Terrace*

Clifftown Parade, Nos. 1 to 13 inclusive only

Clifton Terrace*

Devereux Road*

Prittlewell Square (East and West)*

Runwell Terrace*
