Within **28 days** of the date of this Notice, you must **EITHER**: Make payment in full as described overleaf, **OR**: Make an appeal to the Traffic Penalty Tribunal (TPT).

TPT is an independent body which can appoint an adjudicator to consider your appeal. The adjudicator will make a decision which is legally binding on both you and the Council. An appeal to TPT is free and an adjudicator would not normally award costs against either you or the Council. If you wish to appeal to TPT you should carefully read the attached leaflet, complete the required sections and send it directly to the address on the leaflet.

If payment is not received, and a formal appeal is not made to TPT, within 28 days of this Notice, the Penalty Charge will increase to £«Notice_Surcharge_Penalty» and a Charge Certificate will be served. Failure to pay the increased amount may result in an order for recovery being made against you under the authority of the County Court and a warrant being issued to bailiffs.

Reasons for Rejection of Representations

How to Pay:

By Post: Cheques should be made payable to "*Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council*" crossed "A/c payee only". A receipt will only be issued if a stamped addressed envelope is supplied. Payment should be posted to: Stockport Council, Parking Team, Stopford House, Stockport SK1 3XE. Allow 2 working days for 1st class post and 5 for 2nd class. Do not send cash.

By Telephone: Call 0161 474 4050 - we accept most but not all credit/debit cards.

Online: Using the Council's website at www.stockport.gov.uk/payments

If payment is not received, and a formal appeal is not made to TPT, within 28 days of this Notice, the Penalty Charge will increase to £«Notice_Surcharge_Penalty» and a Charge Certificate will be served. Failure to pay the increased amount may result in an order for recovery being made against you under the authority of the County Court and a warrant being issued to bailiffs.

If you disagree with the council's decision you can appeal to the independent adjudicator at the Traffic Penalty Tribunal. The adjudicators are independent of the council and their decision is final.

The website explains what the adjudicator can consider and how to appeal. There is no charge for appealing and costs are not normally awarded. The website gives full details. You will need the information in the box below to hand when you begin your appeal.
