

HOW TO PAY

- **Online:** at www.threerivers.gov.uk/parkingonline
- **By Telephone:** Credit / debit card payments only. Automated payment line 0845 452 4535 (24hours / 7 days a week). Have vehicle details and PCN Number ready.
- **By Post:** using the payment slip below to: The Parking Shop, PO Box 152, Watford, Herts WD18 0YD. Allow 2 working days for 1st class post and 5 for 2nd class.
- **In Person:** at The Parking Shop, 71 - 73 Market Street, Watford, Herts WD18 0PS, Mon - Sat 8am to 6.30pm

You cannot contest this penalty if you make payment.

If you believe that the Penalty should not be paid and wish to challenge this PCN

- **Go to** the Council's website at www.threerivers.gov.uk/parkingonline and follow links to 'Challenge a Penalty Charge Notice'.
- **Write to** The Parking Shop, PO Box 152, Watford, Herts WD18 0YD.

Please quote the PCN Number, the vehicle registration and your name and postal address in all contacts.

Details of the Council's policy and approach to challenges can be found at www.threerivers.gov.uk/parking or seen at the Councils Parking Shop - all cases will be considered on their individual circumstances. If you challenge this PCN within 14 days and the challenge is rejected, the Council will extend the period within which the reduced Penalty Charge may be paid.

IF THE PENALTY CHARGE IS NOT PAID OR CHALLENGED

If the Penalty Charge is not paid on or before the end of the 28 day period as specified on the front of this notice or successfully challenged, the Council may serve a Notice to Owner (NtO) on the owner of the vehicle requiring payment of the Penalty Charge. The owner can then make representations to the Council and may appeal to an independent adjudicator if those representations are rejected. The NtO will contain instructions for doing this.

If you challenge this PCN but the Council issues an NtO anyway, the owner must follow the instructions on the NtO.
