if the Penalty Charge is not paid on or before the end of the 28 day period as specified on the front of this notice or successfully challenged the council may serve a Notice to Owner (NIO) on the owner of the vehicle requiring pay nent of the Penalty Charge. The owner can then make representations to the Council and may appeal to an independent adjudicator if those representations are rejected. The NtO will contain instructions for doing this If you challenge this PCN but the Council issues an NtO anyway, the

Enforcement authority
