Thank you for purchasing a car park season ticket for Bluebell Hill CP.

Your new season ticket is perpetual; this means that when you renew you will not require a replacement adhesive season ticket as all the ticket information is contained in the bar-code. However you must renew at least 24 hours before the expiry date to allow for the bar-code details to be updated.

Lower Castle Fields season ticket – only valid in Lower Castle Fields car park.

Sovereign Way Complex season ticket - only valid in Sovereign Way North, Sovereign Way East and Vale Road car parks. This ticket is not valid in Sovereign Way Mid car park.

Bluebell Hill season ticket - only valid in Bluebell Hill Commuter car park.

Whilst we will continue to send reminder letters it is the responsibility of the holder to ensure they are displaying a current season ticket so we recommend that you make a calendar note as a safeguard.

Faded or damaged season tickets can be exchanged once they are received at the Parking Office at Tonbridge Castle however lost season tickets will incur a £10 replacement charge.



Instructions

The permit/season ticket has a sticky holder attached to it so please follow the instructions carefully.

- Lift up the perforated edge where shown and peel back the tab along the side of the permit.
- Peel back the tabs along the other three sides of the permit. This will reveal all the edges of the sticky holder. You should now remove the permit from this
- You must put the permit on the passenger side of the windscreen on the inside of your vehicle. It must be seen clearly at all times.
- Your windscreen must be clean, dry & dust free before your
