I refer to your letter in connection with the issue of the above Penalty Charge Notice.

Your representations have been considered by this office in accordance with the requirements of the «PCN_Legislation_Title». After full consideration of the representations made and all other circumstance relating to the issue of the Penalty Charge Notice, I have to advise you that the grounds for representation against the Penalty Charge Notice have not been established. This Notice is issued as a formal Notice of Rejection under Part 6 of the «PCN Legislation Title».

Your vehicle was seen parked in «PCN_Street_or_Carpark_Name» on the «PCN Issue Date» in an off-street car park minutes after the expiry time printed on your ticket. A notice was issued at «PCN Issue Time». Parking is restricted in this section of «PCN Street or Carpark Name» between 08:00am to 06:00pm Monday to Sunday, including Bank Holidays, to persons clearly displaying a valid pay & display ticket. This restriction is in accordance with the Torridge District Council (Off -Street Parking Places) Order 2013 as amended.

The registered owner/keeper of the vehicle is liable for any Penalty Charge Notice incurred.

You now have 28 days from the date of service of this Notice of Rejection of Representation to pay the outstanding charge for the above Penalty Charge Notice which is «PCN Amount Outstanding», or alternatively to appeal against its issue. The Notice of Rejection of Representation is deemed to have been served 2 working days after the date of posting given at the head of this letter.

HOW TO APPEAL

If you disagree with the council's decision you can appeal to the independent adjudicator at the Traffic Penalty Tribunal. The adjudicators are independent of the council and their decision is final.

You can appeal now by visiting the tribunal's website: www.trafficpenaltytribunal.gov.uk/appeal

The website explains what the adjudicator can consider and how to appeal. There is no charge for appealing and the costs are not normally awarded. The website gives full details. You will need the information in the box below to hand when you begin your appeal.

- (a) you do not pay the Penalty Charge Notice or
- (b) you do not appeal to the Parking Adjudicator against the Penalty Charge Notice

A Charge Certificate may be served under Part 6 of the «PCN Legislation Title».
