A copy of this order is available for inspection at the Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX from 8.45am to 5.15pm Monday to Thursday and 8.45am to 4.45pm, Friday.

A Penalty Charge Notice for £50 will be issued for the following reasons:

- 1. Failing to park wholly within a marked parking bay.
- Failing to obtain and correctly display a pay and display ticket or season ticket so that all relevant details can be seen.
- 3. Parking after the explry of pald for time.
- Parking with additional payment made to extend the stay beyond the time first purchased (meter feeding).
- 5. Parking for longer than the maximum period permitted.
- 6. Re-parking within 1 hour of leaving.

A Penalty Charge Notice for £70 will be issued for the following reasons:

- Unauthorised use of a bay reserved for use by a different class of vehicle (i.e. motorcycles).
- Parking in a designated disabled bay without a valid disabled persons badge.
- 3. Parking in a restricted area of the car park.
- Parking in an electric vehicles' charging place during restricted hours without charging.
- Parking in a season ticket holder only bay during the restricted hours without clearly displaying a valid season ticket.
