HOW TO PAY

Methods of Payment. You can pay your Penalty Charge in any of the following ways:

- By credit/debit card by calling our 24 hours payment line on (0845) 658 2400. Calls are charged at local rate.
- By credit/debit card to www.bournemouth.gov.uk/parking
- Alternatively, you may pay by credit/debit card by calling this office on (01202) 454806 or (01202) 451489 during office hours.
- By cheque or postal order. Do not send cash in the post. Please make cheques/postal orders payable to Bournemouth Borough Council and send to Enforcement and Parking Services, Town Hall Annexe, St. Stephens Road, Bournemouth, BH2 6EA. PLEASE WRITE PENALTY CHARGE NOTICE NOTICE NUMBER ON THE REVERSE OF THE CHEQUE/PO.
- By cash/cheque/card at the above address during office hours: Monday to Thursday 09:00 to 16:30 and Friday 09:00 to 16:00 excluding bank and public holidays.
- Minimum coinage accepted is a £1.00 coin and a maximum of £35.00 in £1.00 coins is accepted towards a Penalty Charge Notice. Please ask for a receipt if paying by cash.

IF YOU BELIEVE THAT THE PENALTY SHOULD NOT BE PAID AND WISH TO CHALLENGE THIS PCN

If you challenge this PCN within 14 days and the challenge is rejected, the Council will generally extend the period within which the reduced penalty charge may be paid.

IF THE PENALTY CHARGE IS NOT PAID OR CHALLENGED

If the penalty charge is not paid on or before the end of the 28-day period as specified on the front of this notice or successfully challenged, the Council may serve a Notice to Owner (NtO) on the owner of the vehicle requiring payment of the penalty charge. The owner can then make formal representations to the Council and may appeal to an independent adjudicator if those representations are rejected. The NtO will contain instructions for doing this.
