Enforcement procedures in respect of on street parking contraventions are administered on behalf of Kent County Council, by Canterbury City Council.

If the penalty charge is not paid before the end of the 28 day period as specified on the front of this Notice or successfully challenged, the Council may serve a Notice to Owner (NtO) to the keeper of the vehicle, requesting payment. The NtO will describe how the keeper can make representations to the Council. If rejected, how to appeal to an independent Adjudicator. Further information on the appeals procedure can be found at www.trafficpenaltytribunal.gov.uk

If you wish to appeal against the notice, you do so in writing quoting the Penalty Charge Number by post or online at www.canterbury.gov.uk/parking. All appeals must be in writing and telephone challenges will not be accepted. All cases will be considered on their individual circumstances. Progression of the charge will be put on hold pending our reply. If we receive your appeal not later than 14 days beginning with the date of service and your challenge is rejected, the Council may re-offer the 14 day discount period.
