



TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

1. The applicant must reside at the property described within the application.
2. The property must be within an area subject to limited waiting restrictions where a residential exemption applies and is signed as such.
3. The Permit is valid only in the areas the residence of application.
4. The vehicle displaying the Permit must have a current vehicle excise and current MOT if applicable.
5. The vehicle displaying the Permit must not exceed 5 metres in length or 2.8 metres in height.
6. The Permit is valid only for a motor vehicle.
7. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that a valid parking permit is displayed at all times or a Penalty Charge Notice may be issued.
8. The Permit must be clearly visible and able to be fully read by a civil enforcement officer from outside the vehicle.
9. The Permit is only valid for the vehicle whose registration number is entered on the permit.
10. The Permit must not be altered or defaced in any way.
11. The Permit may not be electronically copied or reproduced. Permits that have not been issued by the issuing authority are not valid.
12. A Visitor Permit that is altered in any way will be invalid.
13. Failure to comply with these conditions of use will result in the cancellation of the Permit.
14. This Permit only applies in disc parking bays where there is a resident exemption.

RESIDENT AND VISITOR PERMITS DO NOT GUARANTEE THE USER A PARKING SPACE.

RESIDENT AND VISITOR PERMITS DO NOT ALLOW PARKING ON YELLOW LINES DURING PRESCRIBED HOURS. THIS ACTION MAY RESULT IN A PENALTY CHARGE NOTICE BEING ISSUED.
