

Conditions of Use

A Visitor Permit is only valid if:

1. The driver has scratched all sections showing the arrival hour, date, month and area the vehicle is parked. Only one box in each section should be scratched.
2. The permit is clearly displayed in the front windscreen so that all sections are visible to the Civil Enforcement Officer.
3. The vehicle to which it is affixed is within one of the following classes: Vehicles which do not weigh an un-laden weight of over 2 tonnes (40cwt) within a Resident's Parking Area, OR 1.5 tonnes, (30cwt) within an off street car park.
4. A Visitor Permit is only valid for the period shown. If you stay longer you must affix a further permit at the expiry of the first permit.
5. Is only valid for one use and is not for re-sale.
6. No more than one permit is to be displayed in a vehicle at any one time.
7. Parking is only permitted in the area stated on the front of the booklet and each permit must be scratched off accordingly.
8. Any misuse of a Visitor Permit may result in the applicant/resident being unable to purchase further books.
9. Any alteration or failure to adhere to any of these conditions shall make the permit invalid and any restrictions, dispensations afforded by this permit will be disregarded and may result in the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice.
