ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of the conditions of use of with-flow bus lanes on roads for which Sheffield City Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

- 1. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign A") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered NP 958.12; and
- 2. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign B") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered NP 959.10; and
- 3. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 21 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Directions"), the authorised signs A and B may be placed in combination with a plate conforming to diagram 961 in Schedule 5 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations"); and
- 4. directs that the authorised sign A shall be used in conjunction with the road marking shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the 2002 Regulations when laid diagonally; and



- 5. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 18 of the 2002 Directions, the authorised sign B may be used in conjunction with the road markings shown in diagram 1048 and 1049 in Schedule 6 to the 2002 Regulations; and
- 6. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised signs A and B may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
- 7. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised signs A and B on the said roads shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A and B and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The "solo motor cycle" symbol incorporated into the authorised signs A and B refers to a motor cycle without a side car and having two wheels.

The "authorised vehicles" legend incorporated into the authorised signs A and B refers to Private Hire Vehicles with suitable side markings as approved by Sheffield City Council, operating under a licence issued by a Local Authority; vehicles with suitable side markings, as approved by Sheffield City Council, carrying persons on behalf of the National Health Service for medical reasons; or vehicles with suitable side markings, as approved by Sheffield City Council, being operated on behalf of a Local Authority for educational or care reasons.



The provisions of Regulations 12, 18, 19 and 24 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign A in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 958 in Schedule 5 to those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18, 19 and 24 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign B in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 959 in Schedule 5 to those Regulations.
