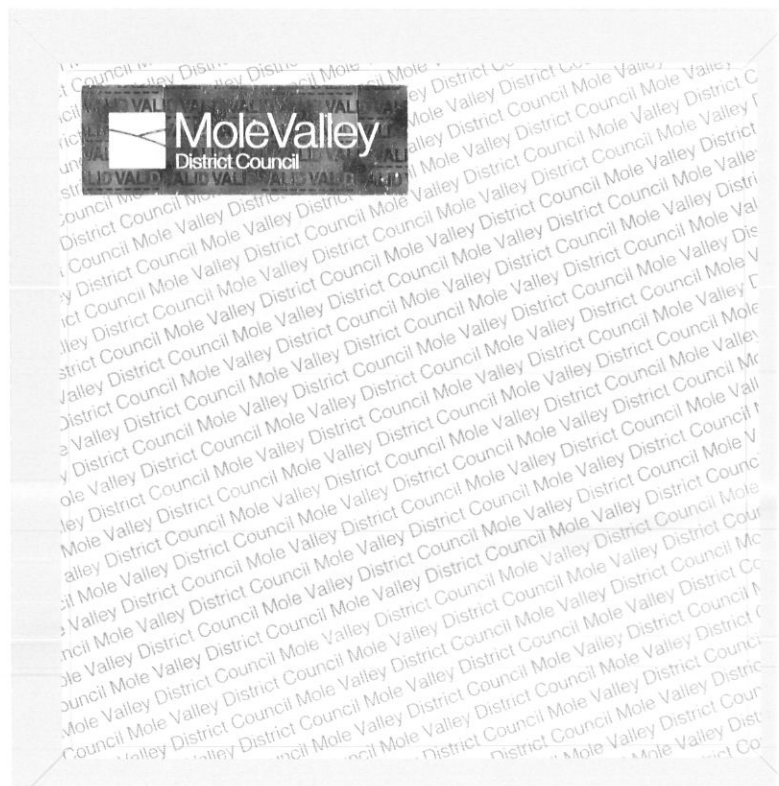
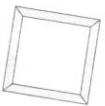


INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove the square perforated area away from the A4 sheet using the perforations.
2. Peel off the shaded area to expose adhesive holder around square permit.
3. Attach permit to windscreen using adhesive holder.



CONDITIONS OF USE

- Your new permit is attached. Please examine it to make sure the details of your vehicle, location in which you park and permit type are all correct.
- Your permit must be clearly displayed so that all the details on the face of the permit can be readily seen from the front windscreen. If the permit is not clearly displayed a Penalty Charge Notice will be issued.
- Your permit must not be assigned or transferred to any other vehicle or person.
- Your permit must be surrendered to the parking office regardless of whether a refund is applicable once the permit is no longer required.
- The permit must only be used in the vehicle displaying the same registration number for which it was issued. To obtain a replacement permit you must surrender your old permit regardless of it being permanent or on a temporary basis.
- If you lose your permit or it is stolen or destroyed, a replacement permit can be issued to you at a fee of £5.
- The permit should not be defaced in any way. If a permit is found defaced a Penalty Charge Notice will be issued and the right to have a permit will be withdrawn.
- The permit does not guarantee you a parking space.

INSTRUCTIONS

- The permit must be clearly displayed at all times in the windscreen of the vehicle. Failure to do so will result in the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice.
- Where a vehicle registration number is indicated the permit is non-transferable between vehicles.
- The issue of a permit does not guarantee the holder a parking space nor does it render the council subject to any liability in respect of loss or damage to any vehicle in a parking place or the contents or fittings of any such vehicle.
- Responsibility for applying for renewal rests with the permit holder.
- This permit is the property of Mole Valley District Council to whom it should be returned when the vehicle is disposed of or otherwise ceases to operate.
- The Council reserves the right to withdraw the permit if it is found to be misused.
