A Penalty Charge Notice for £50 will be issued for the following reasons:

1. Failing to park wholly within a marked parking bay.
2. Failing to obtain and correctly display a pay and display ticket or season ticket so that all relevant details can be seen.
3. Parking after the expiry of paid for time.
4. Parking with additional payment made to extend the stay beyond the time first purchased (meter feeding).
5. Parking for longer than the maximum period permitted.
6. Re-parking within 1 hour of leaving.

A Penalty Charge Notice for £70 will be issued for the following reasons:

1. Unauthorised use of a bay reserved for use by a different class of vehicle (i.e. motorcycles).
2. Parking in a designated disabled bay without clearly displaying a valid disabled persons badge.
3. Parking in a restricted area of the car park.
4. Parking in an electric vehicles' charging place during restricted hours without charging.
5. Parking in a short stay bay without clearly displaying a pay and display ticket not exceeding 3 hours maximum stay.
