7am - 4pm - Permit parking only  
4pm - Midnight - £2.00 flat rate

### **Saturday and Sunday**

7am - 5pm  
£0.60 - 1 hour  
£1.20 - 2 hours  
£1.80 - 3 hours  
£2.40 - 4 hours  
£5.00 - All day to Midnight

### **5pm - Midnight - £2.00 flat rate**

(this tariff only applies for tickets purchased after 5pm)

## THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2007

A copy of this order is available for inspection at the Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX from 8.45am to 5.15pm Monday to Thursday and 8.45am to 4.45pm, Friday.

A Penalty Charge Notice for £50 will be issued for the following reasons:

1. Failing to park wholly within a marked parking bay.
2. Failing to obtain and correctly display a pay and display ticket or permit so that all relevant details can be seen.
3. Parking after the expiry of paid for time.
4. Parking with additional payment made to extend the stay beyond the time first purchased (meter feeding).
5. Parking for longer than the maximum period permitted.
6. Re-parking within 1 hour of leaving.
7. Parked in the car park when closed.

A Penalty Charge Notice for £70 will be issued for the following reasons:

1. Unauthorised use of a bay reserved for use by a different class of vehicle (i.e. motorcycles).
2. Parking in a designated disabled bay without a valid disabled persons badge.
3. Parking in a restricted area of the car park.
4. Parking in an electric vehicles' charging place during restricted hours without charging.
