- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 🖘 January 2006 and may be cited as The Allerdale Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2005 (Amendment No1) Order 2006.
- 2. (1) Any reference in this Order to "the Order of 2005" is a reference to "The Allerdale Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2005".

(2) The interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Order amends the car parks specified by name in Schedule 2 of the Order of 2005 by the inclusion of additional parking places at Keswick Library Heads Lane, Keswick, Fletcher Close, Cockermouth, and St Joseph's Church Crown Street, Cockermouth.

- 3. United Reformed Church, Main Street, Cockermouth


Allerdale Borough Council Off Street parking places are regulated under the Road traffic Act 1991 using Decriminalised Powers.




