THE ALLERDALE BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2005
(AMENDMENT No. 1) ORDER 2006

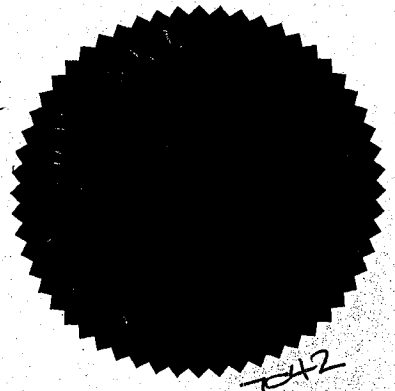
WHEREAS the Council of the Borough of Allerdale (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of the powers of the said Council under Sections 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of the Act of 1984, of all other powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 6th January 2006 and may be cited as The Allerdale Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2005 (Amendment No1) Order 2006.
2. (1) Any reference in this Order to "the Order of 2005" is a reference to "The Allerdale Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2005".
(2) The interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Order amends the car parks specified by name in Schedule 2 of the Order of 2005 by the inclusion of additional parking places at Keswick Library Heads Lane, Keswick, Fletcher Close, Cockermouth, and St Joseph's Church Crown Street, Cockermouth.
4. The Order of 2005 shall remain unaltered in all other respects.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

It is considered necessary Make an amendment to the Allerdale Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2005.

Particular reasons for making Amendment Order No1 of 2006 are to respond to formal requests made by Cumbria County Council and private landowners for the control and regulation of parking on their land at :-

1. Keswick Library – Heads Lane, Keswick
2. Fletcher Close, Cockermouth
3. United Reformed Church, Main Street, Cockermouth

Allerdale Borough Council Off Street parking places are regulated under the Road traffic Act 1991 using Decriminalised Powers.

The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 Act remains the appropriate legislation under which the new Order must be made.
