

**ASHFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL
(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT 1) ORDER 2021**

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Ashford Borough Council ("the Council") and in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33, 35, 124 and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and section 43 and Schedule 3 of the Road Traffic Act 1991 ("the 1991 Act") and of all other powers enabling it in the behalf and with the consent of the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

AMENDMENTS

The Ashford Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 (hereafter referred to as "the Principal Order") is hereby amended and shall have effect as though:

Items 3(1) to 3(4) of 'Interpretation' in the Ashford Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2019 (as amended) shall be replaced with the attached items 3(1) to 3(4).

Items 7(1) and 7(3) relating to the use of parking places in the Ashford Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 (as amended) shall be replaced with the attached items 7(1) and 7(3).

Items 9(1) to 9(5) relating to the issue of season tickets in the Ashford Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 (as amended) shall be replaced with the attached items 9(1) to 9(5).

Items 10(1) to 10(5) relating to the issue of permits in the Ashford Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 (as amended) shall be replaced with the attached items 10(1) to 10(5).

ADDITION

Item 24 relating to authority to refuse entry into a car park shall be added to the Ashford Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 (as amended).

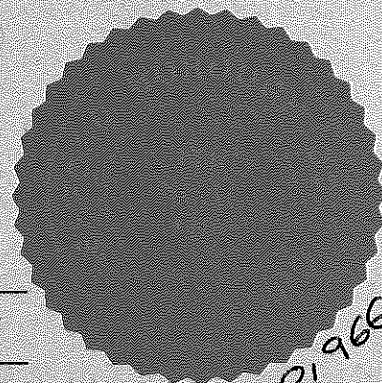

Appendix 1 Section D(5)

Interpretation

3 (1) In this Order the following expressions have the meanings assigned to them except where the context requires otherwise:

"the 1984 Act"	means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
"the 1991 Act"	means the Road Traffic Act 1991
"the 2004 Act"	means the Traffic Management Act 2004
"Barrier Controlled car park"	means a car park whereby access into and out of is controlled by barriers linked to Pay Stations or other payment systems. The exemptions for Blue Badge holders for payment of parking charges may not apply in Barrier Controlled car parks.
"Camper Van"	has the same meaning as "Motor Caravan" (see below)
"Civil Enforcement Officer"	means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise Parking Places and enforce the provisions of this Order and as is defined by Section 76(a) of the 2004 Act
"Coach"	has the same meaning as that which is set out in Regulation 3(2) of the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986 S.I. 1078
"the Council"	means Ashford Borough Council
"Disabled Person's Badge"	has the same meaning as that which is set out in Regulation 3(1) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 S.I. 683
"Driver"	in relation to a Vehicle in a Parking Place means the person driving or having control or charge of the said Vehicle, or the person having driven or having had control or charge of the Vehicle that entered or was left in the Parking Place
"Electric Charging Point"	Means an installation adjacent to a parking bay for the purposes of recharging the battery of an electric vehicle by way of a connecting lead
"Electric Vehicle"	Means a motor vehicle which is powered either wholly or partially by electricity and is capable of being charged from an external source.
"Electric Vehicle Charging Place"	Means a parking bay specified in Schedule 2 provided and indicated by surface markings and signage located within the boundaries of the parking place, where a charging point is provided for the use of charging electric powered vehicles
"Goods Vehicle"	means a motor Vehicle constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description
"Invalid Carriage"	has the same meaning as that set out in Section 136(5) of the 1984 Act
"Licensed Taxi"	means a Vehicle licensed as a hackney carriage under section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, as amended

"Minibus"	has the same meaning as that that which is set out in Regulation 3(2) of the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986
"Motor Caravan"	has the same meaning as Special Purpose Vehicle (Code 'SA') which is set out in Section 5.1 of EU Commission Regulation No 678/2011, as amended
"Motor Cycle"	has the same meaning as that that which is set out in section 3 of the Roads Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986
"Off-street Plans"	means the Ashford Borough Off-Street Plans which are incorporated into this Order pursuant to Article 1(2) hereof.
"Owner"	has the meaning assigned to it by Section 92(1) of the Traffic Management Act 2004.
"Parking Bay"	means an area in a Parking Place delineated by white, yellow (or otherwise) markings to indicate the position in which a Vehicle shall be parked in that parking bay.
"Parking Charge"	means an amount ascertained by reference to the scales specified in Column 8 of Schedule 2 (or such other amount as shall be notified in accordance with Section 35C (1) of the 1984 Act) which has been paid at; a Ticket Machine, or to a Civil Enforcement Officer, or by using the Council's "pay by phone" arrangements or as otherwise deemed appropriate by the Council under the provisions of this Order in respect of a Vehicle left in that Parking Place for a parking period.
"Parking Disc"	has the same meaning as that which is set out in Regulation 8(5) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 S.I. 683.
"Parking Period"	means a period of time within the chargeable hours set out in Column 5 of Schedule 2 for which a Parking Charge has been paid.
"Parking Place"	has the same meaning as that set out in Section 32(4) (b) of the 1984 Act and is as stipulated in Column 1 of Schedule 2 and on the relevant Off-Street Plan.
"Parking Ticket"	means a ticket issued in accordance with Article 7(1) identifying a specific Parking Place, date and time of expiry of the Parking Period.

"Pay and display"	means a system of payment of a parking charge for the parking of motor Vehicles used at car parks where pre-paid tickets must be obtained and be displayed in the appropriate manner within the Vehicle for the entire period that the Vehicle is parked, unless payment for parking has been made by "pay by phone".
"Pay by phone"	<p>means a method of payment for a parking period whereby a parking charge (and any appropriate administration charge*) is collected by a Borough Council appointed third party, via an arranged account, with payment being made over the telephone or by other electronic system (including via the internet) by credit or debit card or other means of secure authorised payment.</p> <p>*"Pay by Phone" transactions attract additional charges to those stated within the schedules of the order as the 'scale of Parking Charges' to be paid by the applicant to cover the administration of th/e operator and costs incurred during the transaction process.</p> <p>The additional transaction charges should be made public by the operator as part of the transaction process.</p> <p>Telephony charges incurred in the costs of making the transaction depend on network provider and phone service and are the responsibility of the applicant.</p>
"Pay to park"	is to be construed in like fashion to "Pay and Display"
"Pay Station"	Means the equipment installed at a Barrier Controlled car park to enable payment of the appropriate parking charge to be made.
"Penalty Charge"	means a charge set in accordance with the provisions of the 1991 Act payable to the council following the issue of a penalty charge notice.
"Permit"	means a non-transferable document issued by the council in accordance with Article 10 which when displayed in the Relevant Position and used in accordance with the particulars stipulated thereon provides authority for the specified Vehicle to remain in a specified Parking Place(s) without displaying a valid parking ticket.
"Residents Permit"	Means a form of Virtual Permit which relating to use specifically to locations stipulated in Schedule 2 of this Order

"Relevant Position"	<p>means:</p> <p><i>In the case of a Parking Ticket, Permit or a Season Ticket -</i> a Vehicle displays a Parking Ticket or a Season Ticket in the Relevant Position if the said ticket is exhibited in a conspicuous position within the said Vehicle so that the side of the ticket marked "THIS SIDE UP" is clearly visible and can be read from outside the said Vehicle;</p> <p><i>In the case of a Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc -</i> A Vehicle displays a Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc in the Relevant Position if the badge or disc is displayed in accordance with Regulation 4 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 S.I. 683;</p>
"Season Ticket"	means a non-transferable season ticket issued by the Council in accordance with Article 9 which when displayed in the Relevant Position shall permit the Vehicle(s) specified on the said season ticket to park without displaying a valid parking ticket.
"Taxi"	has the same meaning as "licensed taxi" (see above)
"Ticket Machine"	means an apparatus installed in a parking place to issue a parking ticket.
"Vehicle"	has the same meaning as that assigned to "motor Vehicle" in section 136(1) of the 1984 Act.
"Virtual Permit"	means an electronic record of a non-transferable permit held by the Council in accordance with Article 10 for which payment for a parking period whereby a charge (and any appropriate administration charge) is collected by the Council, via an arranged account, with payment being made by an electronic system (including via the internet) by credit or debit card or other means of secure authorised payment. A Virtual Permit exempts a person leaving a vehicle in a permitted parking place from the requirements in this Order to display a ticket, permit or waiver.
"Virtual Season Ticket"	means an electronic record of a non-transferable season ticket held by the Council in accordance with Article 9 for which payment for a parking period whereby a charge (and any appropriate administration charge) is collected by the Council, via an arranged account, with payment being made by an electronic system (including via the internet) by credit or debit card or other means of secure authorised payment. A Virtual Season Ticket exempts a person leaving a vehicle in a permitted parking place from the requirements in this Order to display a ticket, permit or waiver.

3 (2) Except where the context otherwise requires, references in this Order to Articles and Schedules are references to the Articles of and Schedules to this Order.

3 (3) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3 (4) Any reference in this Order to any enactment, shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.

Parking Places

4 Each of the Parking Places specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 and as identified and defined in the Off-Street Plans may only be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the parking of such classes of Vehicles, in such positions, on such days and during such hours as are specified in Columns 2 to 5 respectively of Schedule 2 in relation to that Parking Place.

Class, Position and Parking Charges

5 (1) A Vehicle shall not enter or remain in a Parking Place unless the said Vehicle falls within a class specified in Column 2 of Schedule 2 in relation to that Parking Place.

5 (2) A Vehicle shall not enter or remain in a Parking Bay reserved by means of a sign or surface marking for use by Vehicles of a class specified in column 2 of schedule 2 unless the said Vehicle is of the class for which the said Parking Bay is so reserved.

5 (3) A Vehicle shall be wholly parked within the limits of a Parking Bay indicated in Column 3 of Schedule 2 in relation to the Parking Place in which that Parking Bay is situated.

5 (4) Save as provided for in Article 7(5), the driver of a Vehicle on causing that Vehicle to remain in a Parking Place at any time during the chargeable hours specified in column 5 of Schedule 2 in relation to the Parking Place in which that Vehicle is parked shall pay, or cause to be paid, the appropriate parking charge.

Maximum Period for which a Vehicle may remain in a Parking Place and Restrictions on Return Periods

6 (1) Except with the permission of the council no Vehicle shall remain in a Parking Place for longer than the maximum period stipulated in Column 6 of Schedule 2 in relation to that Parking Place.

6 (2) No Vehicle that has been caused to remain in a Parking Bay shall (except with the permission of the Council) remain in that Parking Bay save in accordance with that which is stipulated by any sign or surface marking in relation to that Parking Bay.

6 (3) No Vehicle that has been caused to remain in a Parking Bay shall (except with the permission of the Council) be returned to any Parking Bay within the same Parking Place, before the expiry of any period of time stipulated in Column 7 of Schedule 2 in relation to that Parking Place or as is stipulated by any sign or surface marking in relation to that Parking Bay.

Use of Parking Places

7 (1) Save as provided for in Article 7(5), no Vehicle shall remain in a Parking Place unless it displays in the Relevant Position at all times while it remains in that Parking Place a valid parking ticket issued by a ticket machine, a civil enforcement officer or as otherwise deemed appropriate by the Council, unless a virtual permit or virtual season ticket has been issued by the Council for the Vehicle for that location, or payment for parking at that location has been made by "pay by phone";

7 (2) Save as provided for in Article 7(5), no Vehicle shall remain in a Parking Place after the expiry date and time identified on the parking ticket displayed in the Relevant Position in that Vehicle or where payment for parking at that location has been made by "pay by phone", no Vehicle shall remain in a Parking Place after the expiry of the parking period for that location paid using the "pay by phone" system.

7 (3) A Vehicle shall not remain in a Parking Place or part thereof that has been reserved by means of a sign or surface marking for use by:

Permit-holder Vehicles

(a) Specific permit-holders holding a valid permit for the said Parking Place or part thereof unless the said Vehicle displays a valid permit for that Parking Place or part thereof in accordance with Article 7(5) (c).

Disabled Person's Badge-holders Vehicles

(b) Disabled Person's Badge-holders unless the said Vehicle displays a valid disabled person's badge in accordance with Article 7(5) (b);

Loading and Unloading

(c) Vehicles in connection with loading and unloading unless the said Vehicle is being loaded and/or unloaded in accordance with Article 7(5)(g);

Coaches, Motor Cycles, Camper Vans, Minibuses, Licensed Taxis or Goods Vehicles

(d) Coaches, Motor Cycles, Camper Vans, Minibuses, Licensed Taxis or Goods Vehicles unless the said Vehicle is of the class for which that Parking Place or part thereof is so reserved.

Electric Vehicles

(e) An Electric Vehicle in the process of being charged at an electric vehicle charge point.

(f) The driver of an electric vehicle shall not permit it to wait in an Electric Vehicle Charging Place unless it is being charge throughout the period within which it is parked in the Electric Vehicle Parking Place

7 (4) A parking ticket is not valid if it is transferred between Parking Places or between Vehicles.

7 (5) The following exemptions apply in relation to Articles 5(4), 7(1) and 7(2) in the specified circumstances:

(a) A Vehicle displaying at all times while it remains in a Parking Place a valid season ticket in the Relevant Position, issued in accordance with Article 9 for the specified Parking Place(s) for which the season ticket was issued and in which the said Vehicle is situated;

(b) A Vehicle displaying at all times while it remains in a Parking Place a valid Disabled Person's Badge and parking disc in the Relevant Position PROVIDED THAT the said parking disc displays the quarter hour period during which the period of exempted parking began. This exemption shall not apply where such a Vehicle remains in a Parking Place for a period exceeding 3 hours in which case the parking charge in respect of the full duration of time that the Vehicle was first parked in the Parking Place shall be due and payable. For the purposes of this paragraph, a Vehicle shall be deemed to remain in a Parking Place if it departs from and returns to any Parking Bay within that Parking Place within 1 hour;

(c) A Vehicle displaying at all times while it remains in a Parking Place a valid permit issued in accordance with Article 10 in the Relevant Position and complying with the particulars stipulated thereon;

(d) A Motor Cycle parked in a Parking Bay identified by signs and/or surface markings as provided for the use of motor cycles only;

(e) A Vehicle parked in an area identified by signs and/or surface markings as provided in connection with the depositing of appropriate items in recycling receptacles positioned in a Parking Place for so long as is reasonably required to deposit the said items;

(f) A Vehicle parked in a Parking Bay identified by signs and/or surface markings as provided for use in connection with loading and/or unloading PROVIDED THAT goods are being continually loaded onto the Vehicle or unloaded from the Vehicle and that the Vehicle does not remain longer than the period stipulated on any nearby sign relating to that Parking Bay.

(g) A Vehicle displaying at all times while it remains in a Parking Place a valid permit issued in accordance with Article 10 in the Relevant Position and complying with the particulars stipulated thereon;

(h) A Vehicle parked in a Barrier-Controlled car park where payment is required to be made prior to exit from the car park.

7 (6) For the purposes of this Article a Vehicle shall be deemed to remain in a Parking Place if it departs from and returns to that Parking Place within one hour.

Closure or Suspension of Use of a Parking Place

8 (1) Notwithstanding any of the provisions of this Order the Council may by notice displayed on or near a Parking Place close or suspend that Parking Place or any part thereof for any period and may use such Parking Place or any part thereof for any purpose.

8 (2) No Vehicle shall enter or remain in a Parking Place or any part thereof that has been closed or suspended as described in paragraph (1) of this Article without the prior consent in writing of the Council.

8 (3) No Vehicle shall enter or remain in a Parking Place outside the days of operation specified in Column 4 of Schedule 2 in relation to that Parking Place.

8 (4) No Vehicle shall enter or remain in a Parking Place outside the hours of operation specified in Column 5 of Schedule 2 in relation to that Parking Place.

Season Tickets

9 (1) The Council may at its discretion issue season tickets or virtual season tickets for use in Parking Places which shall permit the Vehicle(s) specified on the said season ticket to park without displaying a valid parking ticket. Where applicable, the charge for such season ticket is as stipulated in Column 8 of Schedule 2 in relation to that Parking Place (or such other amount as shall be notified in accordance with Section 35C(1) of the 1984 Act) and shall be payable in advance.

9 (2) A season ticket or virtual season ticket may be used only in respect of the Vehicle or one of the Vehicles for which it is issued.

9 (3) No person shall use a season ticket or virtual season ticket otherwise than in accordance with this Order, the conditions set out in the Council's application form or any conditions set out on the season ticket or any conditions set out on the Council's online application system.

9 (4) Any season ticket or virtual season ticket issued by the Council remains the property of the Council and is not transferable to another Vehicle or Parking Place.

9 (5) A Vehicle is not parked in accordance with this Article unless the Season Ticket is displayed in the Relevant Position save for the vehicle having been issued with a Virtual Season Ticket.

Permits

10 (1) The Council may at its discretion issue permits or virtual permits which shall permit Vehicle(s) to park in a Parking Place or places without displaying a valid parking ticket.

10 (2) A Permit or virtual permit may be used only in respect of the Vehicle or one of the Vehicles for which it is issued.

10 (3) No person shall use a Permit or virtual otherwise than in accordance with this Order, any other conditions set out on the Permit or any conditions set out in the Council's application form any conditions set out on the Permit or any conditions set out on the Council's online application system.

10 (4) Any Permit or virtual permit issued by the Council remains the property of the Council and is not transferable to another Vehicle or Parking Place.

10 (5) A Vehicle is not parked in accordance with this Article unless the Permit is displayed in the Relevant Position save for the vehicle having been issued with a Virtual Permit.

Penalty Charge

11 If a Vehicle remains in a Parking Place in contravention of any Article contained within this Order a penalty charge will be payable by the owner of that Vehicle.

Other Provisions

12 The Driver of a Vehicle using a Parking Place shall stop the engine as soon as the said Vehicle is in position in the Parking Place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the said Vehicle or to depart from that Parking Place.

13 A Vehicle shall not cause an obstruction in a Parking Place.

14 (1) No person shall use a Vehicle while it is in a Parking Place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near that Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or service.

14 (2) No person shall leave any Vehicle in a Parking Place in connection with the sale or advertising or displaying for sale of that or any other Vehicle.

14 (3) No person shall use any part of a Parking Place or any Vehicle left in a Parking Place:

(a) for sleeping or camping or cooking; or

(b) for the purpose of servicing or washing any Vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that Vehicle to depart from that Parking Place.

15 No person shall in a Parking Place wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the Parking Place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood.

16 No person shall in a Parking Place use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned.

17 In a Parking Place, no person shall:

- (a) Erect or cause to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure without the written consent of the Council;
- (b) Light or cause or permit to be lit any fire.

18 The driver of a Vehicle shall not use a Parking Place as a means of passage proceeding from one road to another.

19 The driver of a Vehicle using a Parking Place shall not sound any audible warning instrument save in circumstances where such action is reasonably required.

20 (1) If a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place other than in accordance with the provisions of this Order a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may alter or cause to be altered the position of that Vehicle so that its position is in accordance with the said provisions.

20 (2) If a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place in contravention of any of the foregoing provisions of this Order a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may remove the said Vehicle from that Parking Place or arrange for such removal.

20 (3) For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency a person authorised in that behalf by the Council or a police constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a Vehicle in a Parking Place or remove or arrange for the removal of that Vehicle from that Parking Place.

20 (4) Any person altering or causing the alteration of the position of a Vehicle by virtue of paragraph (1) of this Article or removing or causing the removal of a Vehicle by virtue of paragraphs (2) or (3) of this Article may do so by towing or driving the said Vehicle or in such other manner as he may think reasonably necessary to enable the position of the said Vehicle to be altered or the said Vehicle to be removed.

20 (5) Any person removing or arranging for the removal of a Vehicle by virtue of paragraphs (2) or (3) of this Article shall make arrangements as he considers

to be reasonably necessary for the safety of the said Vehicle in the place to which it is removed.

21 Where in a Parking Place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:

- (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from the Parking Place; or
- (b) indicating that a Vehicle using the Parking Place shall proceed in a specified direction within the Parking Place

no person shall drive or permit to be driven any Vehicle:

- (i) so that it enters the Parking Place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the Parking Place otherwise than by an exit so indicated; or
- (ii) in a direction other than so specified.

22 No person shall except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council in that behalf drive or permit to be driven any Vehicle in a Parking Place for any purpose other than the purpose of leaving that Vehicle in the Parking Place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the Parking Place.

23 No person shall in any Parking Place without the consent of the Council distribute or affix to any Vehicle left in that Parking Place any literature or leaflets.

24 The council or its Civil Enforcement Officers may refuse entry to any car park or parking bay, to any person or vehicle.
