

COUNTY COUNCIL OF AVONROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967 - SECTION 21VARIATION OF SCHEME FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF CROSSINGS FOR FOOT PASSENGERS

The County Council of Avon in exercise of their powers under Section 21 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, hereby vary the "Scheme for the Establishment of Crossings for Foot Passengers in the County of Avon" approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment on the 13th May 1977, by the addition thereto of the following light controlled (pelican) crossings in the City of Bath -

<u>Location</u>	<u>No. of crossings</u>
Across the southern (westbound) carriageway of Lower Bristol Road at its junction with Pines Way to the central island.	1
Across the northern (eastbound) carriageway of Lower Bristol Road at its junction with Pines Way to the central island.	1
Across the northern (eastbound) carriageway of Pines Way at its junction with Midland Bridge Road to the central island.	1
Across the eastern (southbound) carriageway of Midland Bridge Road at its junction with Pines Way to the central island.	1
Across Lower Bristol Road east of its junction with Midland Bridge Road.	2
