

COUNTY COUNCIL OF AVON

(CITY OF BATH) (DOCTORS' STREET PARKING  
PLACES) (VARIATION NO.2) ORDER 1986

The County Council of Avon (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 45, 46, 49 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 17th. March 1986 and may be cited as the County Council of Avon (City of Bath) (Doctors' Street Parking Places) (Variation No.2) Order 1986.
2. The City of Bath (Doctors' Street Parking Places) Order 1972 as varied by the County Council of Avon (City of Bath) (Doctors' Street Parking Places) (Amendment No.1) Order 1976 is hereby varied further and shall have effect as though:-

in the Schedule thereto there were omitted the item numbered D2 and inserted the item so numbered set out in the Schedule to this Order;
