

COUNTY COUNCIL OF AVON

(CITY OF BATH) (CENTRAL AREA) (STREET PARKING PLACES)  
(CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO. 2) ORDER 1991

The County Council of Avon (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 32(1) and 35(1) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 16th December 1991 and may be cited as the County Council of Avon (City of Bath) (Central Area) (Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Variation No. 2) Order 1991.
2. The City of Bath (Central Area) (Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 1986 as varied by the County Council of Avon (City of Bath) (Central Area) (Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Variation No. 1) Order 1987 is hereby varied further and shall have effect as though:-

in Schedule 1 thereto there were substituted for the entry numbered 16 relating to Catharine Place the entry numbered 16 as set out in the Schedule to this Order.
