ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 23
PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

NOTICE is hereby given that the County Council of Avon in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and after consultation with the chief officer of police, intends to vary the "Scheme for the Establishment of Crossings for Foot Passengers in the County of Avon" by the deletion, therefrom, of the following light controlled (pelican) crossings in the City of Bath:-

| <u>Location</u> | <u>No of Crossings</u> |
|--|------------------------|
| Across the eastern (southbound) carriageway of Midland Bridge Road at its junction with Pines Way to the Central Island. | 1 Pelican |
| Across Lower Bristol Road east of its junction with Midland Bridge Road. | 1 Pelican |

It is proposed to replace the crossings with the installation of traffic signals which will incorporate a pedestrian phase at the junction of Midland Bridge Road and Lower Bristol Road.
