

COUNTY OF AVONROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 23  
PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

NOTICE is hereby given that the County Council of Avon in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and after consultation with the chief officer of police, intends to vary the "Scheme for the Establishment of Crossings for Foot Passengers in the County of AVon" by the addition, thereto, of the following uncontrolled (zebra) crossing in the City of Bath:-
