

COUNTY OF AVONROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 23PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

NOTICE is hereby given that the County Council of Avon in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and after consultation with the chief officer of police, intends to vary the "Scheme for the Establishment of Crossings for Foot Passengers in the County of Avon" by the addition, thereto, of the following push button controlled (pelican) crossing in the City of Bath:-

Across the A4 Newbridge Road south west of its junction with Charmouth Road	1 (Pelican)

A copy of the map together with a statement of the Council's reasons may be inspected at the undermentioned offices (callers should report to reception and ask for the Statutory Orders Section) during normal office hours and at Moorland Road Public Library, Moorland Road, Bath during normal opening hours.

Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the County Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.
