

COUNTY OF AVONROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 23PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

NOTICE is hereby given that the County Council of Avon in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and after consultation with the chief officer of police, intends to vary the "Scheme for the Establishment of Crossings for Foot Passengers in the County of Avon" by the addition, thereto, of the following push button-controlled (pelican) crossing in the City of Bath:-

Across A4 Upper Bristol Road west of its junction with Nile Street	1 (Pelican)

A copy of the map together with a statement of reasons may be inspected at the undermentioned offices (callers should report to reception and ask for the Statutory Orders Section) during normal office hours and at Bath Public Library, The Podium, Northgate Street, Bath during normal opening hours.

Objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to the County Solicitor and Deputy Clerk at the undermentioned address quoting reference FRP/P/1/013 by 3rd February 1993. Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the County Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.
