

COUNTY OF AVONROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 23PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

NOTICE is hereby given that the County Council of Avon in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and after consultation with the chief officer of police, intends to vary the "Scheme for the Establishment of Crossings for Foot Passengers in the County of Avon" by the addition thereto, of the following light controlled (pelican) crossing in the District of Wansdyke:-

Across A37 at Pensford Bridge, Pensford north west of its junction with Publow Lane/Stanton Lane.	1 (pelican)

Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the County Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.
