

COUNTY OF AVONROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 23PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

NOTICE is hereby given that the County Council of Avon in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and after consultation with the chief officer of police, intends to vary the "Scheme for the Establishment of Crossings for Foot Passengers in the County of Avon" by the addition thereto, of the following light controlled (pelican) crossings in the District of Wansdyke:-

<u>Location</u>	<u>No. of Crossings</u>
Across Bristol Road (A37) , Temple Cloud north of its junction with Temple Inn Lane	1 (pelican) <i>Installed 29.3.95</i>
Across Frome Road (A362) , Writhlington north west of its junction with Manor Road	1 (pelican) <i>Installed 22.2.95</i>
